3. DELINQUENT TRASH AND REFUSE COLLECTION ACCOUNTS

Report on delinquent trash accounts and the hearing of any objections of the property owners liable for unpaid trash and refuse services in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 8.48 of the Norwalk Municipal Code.

Staff Recommendation: That the Board direct staff to forward the listed properties to the City Council with a recommendation that the delinquent properties be placed on the County Tax Roll unless the outstanding balance is paid prior to July 31, 2017.

Board's Action: Approved staff's recommendation by a vote of 3-0.

4. DELINQUENT WEEDS AND LITTER COLLECTION FEES

Report on the cost of abatement of weeds and litter and the hearing of any objections of property owners liable to be assessed for such abatement in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 8.28 of the Norwalk Municipal Code.

Staff Recommendation: That the Board direct staff to forward the listed properties to the City Council with a recommendation that the delinquent amounts be placed as a lien on the County Tax Roll unless the outstanding balance is paid prior to July 31, 2017.

Board's Action: Approved staff's recommendation by a vote of 3-0.

ORAL COMMUNICATIONS
