



Norwalk Transit System (NTS) was successful in obtaining a Mobile Source Air Pollution Reduction Review Committee (MSRC) grant, funding the purchase of three (3) Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) bus engines; which have been installed on three (3) new NTS 40-foot buses acquired from Gillig Corporation. These new buses, with MSRC engines, will replace the three (3) 2005/06 hybrid New Flyer buses that have reached their useful life expectancy.

These buses were purchased in keeping with the City of Norwalk's commitment to being environmentally friendly. The buses are equipped with technology enhancements that result in the engines producing nearly zero emissions, as CNG burns cleaner than petroleum and contains significantly less pollutants than gasoline.

NTS has previously committed to reducing its carbon footprint by replacing its fleet of diesel/gasoline fueled buses and incorporating zero and/or near zero emission technology, which will have most impact on cleaning the environment.
